

# TEDx University of Delaware Application Information

This document is meant to help people interested in applying to be a speaker with the TEDxUniversityofDelaware. Its purpose is to explain the basic timeline of the application process and some resources.

## Stages

The application process has been split into 3 stages for this year in order to help the committee find the best stories possible and use your time most effectively.

### Stage 1:

This is the stage you are currently in! This stage is meant to learn about who is interested in speaking with TEDx and what their stories are. By completing the application form you have finished this stage. Congrats!

### Stage 2:

The second stage is to better prepare you for creating a TEDx talk. This stage will be another survey which will ask you to provide a more concrete outline and to provide your sources for this talk. These do not have to be finalized and will likely change as you work on your talk but it shows the committee that your talk is personal and factual.

### Stage 3:

The final stage will be an interview with one or multiple members of the committee. This will be casual and is a great chance to explain your talk to a receptive audience. There will be more information on this stage when you reach it.
