Covid Policy

Our corona policy is in line with the UK government guidelines. This year we won't be screening for temperature or checking proof of vaccination or recent negative test (PCR or rapid test). But we're asking you to be responsible: if you have any symptoms or have been in contact with someone tested positive recently, please choose remote participation and watch the conference online, to ensure other attendees' safety. It would be respectful to other attendees that attending people have either vaccination or recent PCR/rapid test, although this won't be enforced.

We provide the following measures at the in-person part of the event:

- Sanitizer dispenser stations will be available inside the venue.
- Bathrooms are cleaned frequently.
- Masks will be offered at the registration desk.

Travel to The United Kingdom

Please consult the up-to-date travel rules for <u>All countries</u> or take a look directly at your country's official Covid information website.

The UK government has removed remaining domestic restrictions in England. When you travel to England, you:

- do **not** need to complete a United Kingdom passenger locator form before you travel
- do not need to take any COVID-19 tests before you travel or after you arrive
- do not need to quarantine when you arrive

Old Red Lion Theatre Pub	The Old Red Lion Theatre in Angel is one of London's best-loved pub theatres. Their mission is to nurture and present the very best new and emerging theatrical talent - Kathy Burke, Abi Morgan and Katie Mitchell to name but a few.



Portobello Road Market	The market area is about 1,028 yards (940 m) long. The market began as many other London markets and mainly sold fresh-food in the 19th century; antiques and wares dealers arrived in the late 1940s and '50s, and gradually antiques have become the main attraction of this market, having a substantial number of them trading mainly on Saturday mornings. It is the largest antiques market in the UK.
Royal Botanic Gardens, Kew	Plants and fungi are vital to the future of food, clean air and medicine. We're fighting against biodiversity loss to save life on Earth
London Design Museum	Located in London, the world's leading museum devoted to contemporary design in every form.
The Clove Club	Iconic Shoreditch restaurant The Clove Club, headed up by Isaac McHale, has two Michelin Stars.


Conference Discord Channels

- MOORGATE STATION (5 min walk) Circle, Metropolitan, Hammersmith & City, Northern, British Rail and Thameslink
- BANK STATION (15 min walk) Central, Northern and Waterloo & City
- LIVERPOOL STREET STATION (15 min walk) Circle, Metropolitan, Hammersmith & City, Central and mainline rail network.


