Their team has shared some items of concern which will guide what documentation is requested from districts in future monitoring events. o They have been much more specific in telling us what evidence may be requested in upcoming monitoring documentation collection. o The person/persons who should attend would be the staff member(s) who will be most responsible for collecting and submitting Title I and Title III program data. We are working to avoid any surprises later on. Anything we can prepare now is a bonus. Especially processes and procedures that we all follow in the T I/III (English Language Development) programs. We can support you now in working together to identify which procedures or processes are not in writing, and share templates with each other to assist schools in getting them developed.
