Homework & Assignments

- Daily homework will consist of 25 minutes of reading and any remaining class work.

- Families should check Infinite Campus regularly to monitor that work is being completed and turned in on time.
- Any missing or late work will be flagged accordingly in Infinite Campus. Download the Infinite Campus Parent Portal to your device and set up notifications.
- To view your child's work from class, we encourage you to have your 5th grader show you their work in Google Classroom on their Chromebook.

Grading

- Students will be given formative assessments throughout each unit to measure understanding and inform our instruction before an end of unit assessment.
- Summative assessments are given at the end of a unit.
- Summative scores in Infinite Campus are averaged and reported at the end of each semester on your child's report card.

Absent Work

Chromebooks & Technology
