I found this Restaurant page on **Facebook**.


This type of sequence falls into the Application funnels.

This restaurant doesn't have a YouTube channel, but there're a few edits of theirs on the net. It's still a form of presence.








It's the platform I found out about the Kazoku Restaurant.




