







Now you are ready to order your books!

In this section of your dashboard, you'll see both a *Master Book List including* all books for all grades, and individual *Book Lists* for each grade. *The Book Lists* share a short rationale for why we chose each book, any relevant notes, and if the book is available in alternate formats such as audiobook or ebook versions. We also note if this book or resource is shared with other grades and how many terms it will be used. For instance, if a book is only used for one term, this might be a good book to look for at your local library rather than purchasing it.






To the right of each book, you will find links to purchase or access the resources needed. To help you access books easily, we often provide two different purchase options. We also link to free versions of resources when available, and clearly mark if a resource is optional. You can keep track of books you have and need with the checkboxes on the left. Remember to only purchase books for the subjects you selected from the course list. If you'd like tips on saving

money on books and supplies, some of our experienced members recorded a <u>video</u> you might find helpful. For example, many members buy books one term at a time to spread out the expense and also to make sure their schedule doesn't change during the year.

Hymns, Spirituals, and Folk Songs. We

used frequently.






Book Videos
