## **IMPORTANT NOTES:**

Manuscripts should present original research contributions and will be refereed. Manuscripts must be submitted electronically via the Open Journal System of *At-Tibyan: Ilmu Alqur'an dan Tafsir* submission web page. Manuscripts can be accepted in Open Office, Microsoft Word, RTF, or WordPerfect document file format. Authors should ensure that their manuscripts are printable on a standard Postscript printer. Charts and graphs should not rely on color for clear interpretation since printing will be black and white only.

Paper length is limited to 20 pages (including all figures, tables, bibliography and appendices). Authors should follow the format found in the *At-Tibyan: Jurnal Ilmu Alqur'an dan Tafsir Paper Template*. Manuscripts should be in one-column page with a font size of 12 points using Times New Arabic type both for text and title, author information, and main section headings. Manuscripts should be formatted for A4 paper. Top, bottom, and side margins should be 3 centimeter.

Paper style should follow the forms given in the *Chicago Manual of Style References–17th edition*. In general, the background and purpose of the study should be stated first, followed by details of the methods, materials, procedures, and equipment used. Findings, discussion and conclusions should follow in that

order. Appendices may be employed where appropriate. *Chicago Manual of Style References–17th edition* should be consulted for details as needed.
