We are lacking media and we should solve those issues in cooperation together with Nordic countries. The situation is serious."

FIE President Roch stated that he has noticed remarkable activity at the Nordic countries. The training camp made in Island is a perfect example. Roch believes that fencing can be developed through larger competition events and wishes to have more fencers at the international level. FIE can organise more training camps for fencers, and coaches. There have been camps all over the Europe. Now the Nordic countries and Mediterrian countries have priority.

EFC Vice-President Jano Kamuti pointed out that it is difficult to make training camps without financing. Without fencing masters fencing will not exist. Kamuti wishes to thank the Icelandic Federation for the efforts they have made for the training camp. Kamuti is enthusiastic that EFC can financially support this training camp in Reykjavik. EFC is open to organize training camps in small countries.

FIE President Roch wishes to have good cooperation together with FIE and EFC and work together for the future of fencing. Roch believes that FIE can give in future financial help for the Sabre centre in Reykjavik.

Kimmo Pentikäinen stated that Finland is committed to participate individual Nordic fencing projects with the conditions stated on the cooperative proposal made by Estonia and Finland. He said that Finland believes there cannot be truly cooperative development projects of fencing without cooperative model as presented in the proposal or that Nordic Fencing Union will take the full responsibility concerning the individual projects. Therefore at the present situation Finland will not participate to the foil project which Denmark is

independently organizing or sabre project and training centre which Iceland is independently organizing.
