

- Severe Allergies:
  - EPI Pen and/or Benadryl and Medication Consent Forms
  - o Allergy Action Plan from Physician
  - o Dietary Accommodation form if food related
- Asthma:
  - o Inhaler and Medication Consent Form
  - o Asthma Action Plan from Physician
- Chronic Conditions
  - Action Plan from Physician and/or School Care Plan

- Diabetes
  - o Medication Consent Form for Insulin
  - o Medication Consent Form for Glucagon
  - Physician's Individualized Plan of Care for current school year
  - o Emergency Supplies for school (contact nurse for details)
- Dietary Restrictions/Non-life-threatening Allergies
  - o Dietary Accommodation Form signed by physician
- Medications During School Hours
  - Medication Consent Form signed by physician

### All forms are due to us on or before the first day of school.
