### **Community Relations Subcommittee Community Dialogue- MINUTES**

- A. Called meeting to Order at 6:00pm.
- B. Community member Carroll Crispo attended the most recent DCI meeting and expressed concern over the athletic concession stand; the elevator has been out of commission since 2019. Why has it not been addressed or fixed? The game analyst was forced to walk alongside the field to call the games. Are we out of ADA compliance? Can we use free cash? Can we reach out to the community to financially assist get things fixed sooner than a budget process? Painting the field house?
- C. Community member Karen Magnifico expressed concerns over a lack of immediate solutions. The timeframe to wait for these immediate fixes for the building, the athletic fields, etc. Where is the revenue from the football program? Why can't we use part of the revenue to pay for these fixes more quickly?
- D. Additional questions asked to the group: Is there an option for the Masco Boosters to fundraise for certain issues under a price point? Are some of the issues being put on hold as part of a potential connection to the "Turf Project?"
- E. Community member Fred Glore shared his agreement with other members that the building was left unattended for many years prior to 2018 with a previous administration. He also expressed the same concern for being able to inquire about prices for immediate fixes through local businesses/boosters etc. F. Glore suggested informing the Boxford Building Commission regarding the structure of inside the athletic concession stand, the second floor, elevator and scoreboard.
- F. 13 members of the Masco Football team were also in attendance. Issues concerning those athletes: The fields, the bathrooms not having urinal dividers.
- G. Lucas Magnifico, Class President mentioned that he designed a T-Shirt for their annual class fundraiser and was denied due to the use of the word Chieftains on the T-Shirt. When he inquired as to why the name of their mascot was not appropriate, the response given from the school was that they were "moving away from that..."
- H. Community member Evangelina Kelly mentioned that Masco turned down the opportunity to have a Fan Bus for 50 student fans to attend the football games because they normally have difficulty getting transportation to the games. The Boosters are providing the bus for them at this point. The response from the school was that having a Fan Bus would not be equitable. Question from C. Crispo, K. Magnifico and E. Kelly: "Why was this turned down for not being equitable when its purpose was having student support from *our school*?"
- I. The next Community Dialogue meeting is scheduled for November 13 and January 22.
