## Expectations of Ms. Pflaum:

- 1) I will provide live instruction during every class period.
- 2) I will be respectful and patient.
- 3) I will provide time for each student to work individually or in small groups on problems during class, to provide a break from listening and from screen time.
- 4) I will provide videos to reinforce class material.
- 5) I will set up small groups so that each student will have a group to work with.
- 6) I will respond within 24 hours to emails or texts on Remind. If I let something slip by, please remind me.
- 7) I will check in on each student to make sure they are academically, mentally, and socially okay.
- 8) I will have extra meetings and videos for social engagement.
- 9) I will allow you to make up any zeros within a unit and, usually, after a unit is over.
- 10) I will evaluate your effort AND your demonstration of mastery over the material.
- 11) I will provide 3 assessments for each unit.

## Expectations of Algebra I students:

- 1. You will attend every class session and be as present as you can be.
- 2. You will ask questions (orally, in private or public chat, through Remind or email) when you need help.
- 3. You will be respectful and patient with all the members of our community.
- 4. You will mute yourself when entering class and stay muted unless speaking.
- 5. If possible (you have the physical and virtual space) you will turn the camera on (I understand why this is often difficult, but it helps me so much to see your faces!!). If your camera is on, be aware of your surroundings.
- 6. You will send in each Google Homework form before the next class. If you don't get it in on time, you will submit it within the week. We have a lot of material to cover, don't get behind! (Also keep up with the weekly check-ins.)
- 7. You will regularly check Google Classroom (at least three times a week) to see the work assigned and get written feedback.
- 8. You will regularly check Pupilpath (at least once a week) to see if your work is accurately recorded or if you are missing work.
- 9. You will bookmark the Google Classroom, my website, or the Bitmoji classroom so that you can quickly access our meetings and material.
- 10. You will keep track of projects and Delta Math assignments, knowing that the deadline may change, but the work has to get done.

- 11. You will come to support (MWF 1:50 to 3:20 or TTh when available) at least once every two weeks for at least 20 minutes to check in or do group work.
