

Dear Pickleball Players,

We are writing to share an important update regarding the use of our pickleball courts that will begin on September 2, 2025.

This decision was made after careful consideration and is necessary to ensure the long-term sustainability and quality of our pickleball program. We deeply value your enthusiasm and support for the sport, and this step will allow us to continue providing a fun, well-maintained, and reliable experience for all players.

Daily Drop-In Play will continue to be \$12.00 for Non-Members.

We understand that many players enjoy playing with others of similar skill levels. For those interested, pickleball players may reserve gym space during open gym times. The cost is \$75 for 90 minutes on half of the gym floor.

We have also looked into what other YMCAs are doing with their pickleball programs, and many have introduced a monthly pickleball membership for both members and non-members. In those cases, members received a much lower rate, giving them an added benefit to their YMCA membership.

While this is something we are considering, we do not plan to make this change right away. If we decide to move forward with a pickleball membership in the future, all players will be notified well in advance and given ample time to prepare.

Pickleball Guidelines

1. Scheduling

- Playtime Scheduler is used as a tool for session sign-ups. Player rankings will not be considered when creating schedules. The gym may be closed for special events, and days when there is no school.

2. Sign-Up Requirements

- All players must list both their first and last name when registering for a session. Players who do not provide both names will be removed from the session without notice.
- We ask that players make every effort to attend sessions they sign up for. If a player misses three registered sessions within a month without attending, they'll be asked to take a two-week break from registering so that spots remain available for others.
- Sessions will be capped at 20 players. However, registration will remain open to 26 spots, with players numbered 21–26 serving as the wait list.

3. Check-In Process

- A list of registered players will be available at the front desk.
- Players must check in at the front desk upon arrival before entering the gym.

4. Play Times

- Pickleball sessions are reserved based on facility availability.
- All players must respect the designated start and end times, including set-up and breakdown of nets and equipment.

5. Court Rotation & Inclusivity

- Courts are open play. All skill levels are welcome, and players will rotate accordingly.
- Players may not refuse to play with others.

6. Sportsmanship

- Treat all players with courtesy and respect.
- Coaching, criticizing, or directing others is not permitted unless feedback is specifically requested.
- If players are not following rules or not playing fairly they may be asked to leave and may lose the ability to play for a certain amount of time.

7. Rule Enforcement & Respect for Staff, Players, and Volunteers

- Staff and volunteers will oversee court rotation, grouping, and play decisions if necessary. Their direction is final and must be respected.
- Players who do not follow the rules or who do not play fairly will be asked to leave.
- Repeated violations may result in loss of playing for a set period of time.
