A Translation Tools

Google Docs translate feature

- This tool will translate an entire Google Document into another language
- Click "Tools" then "Translate document"
- Choose the language you would like to translate the document into.
- Click "Translate" and a new document will be created with the translated text.

Docs Paragraph Translate add-on

- This tool will translate just a selected portion of a Google Document
- Docs add-on Add-on link

Instant search translate

- https://www.google.com/search?q=translate
- This interactive tool can be used to translate a short amount of typed or spoken text.
- Run a Google search for "translate".
- Use the interactive translate tool.
- Good for practicing spoken fluency as well.

Google translate website

- This website will translate typed or pasted text, spoken words, written words, uploaded files, and entire websites (by URL)
- Website https://translate.google.com
- Type in or paste text. Click on portions of translation to see alternate translations.
- Click the microphone icon to speak
- Paste in the web address of a site you want translated
- Click "translate a document" to upload a file

Google translate extension

- This tool will provide a pop-up translation of any selected text on a website.
- Chrome extension Chrome web store link
- Right-click on the extension and choose "Options" to set your language.
- Enable feature for "Display icon that I can click to show pop-up."

- Select any text on a webpage and then click the pop-up translate icon to get a translation.
- Additionally you can click the speaker icon to have the text read aloud.
- You can also click on the extension to translate an entire page.

DeepL Chrome extension

- Chrome extension Chrome web store link
- Free extension that:
 - Translates any text you are reading
 - Translates any text you are writing
 - Is over 3 times more accurate than other translation tools

Google translate mobile app

- Translation tool for your phone
- Android app Google Play Store link
- iOS app App Store link
- Type to enter text
- Use microphone button to speak
- Use pencil button to handwrite
- Use camera button for images
- Use the conversation icon for a live conversation
- Use the transcribe button to get a live transcription of what is being said

Google Lens

- Scan, translate, copy, and read text.
- Identify plants & animals.
- Explore places.
- Scan QR codes
- Can be used as a mobile app lens.google.com
- Or can be accessed in Chrome by right-clicking on an image and choosing "Search image with Google" - Blog post - Tutorial video

• Turn on closed captions

- Click settings gear
- Click "Subtitles"
- Click "Auto-translate"
- Choose the language you want the closed captions translated into

GlotDojo

- Chrome extension link
- Free translation extension with many of the common translation features, but with a couple extra unique features including:
- Multiple subtitles for videos so you can view up to three different translations simultaneously.
- Option to view images of any selected word (along with normal translation and pronunciation).

Slide Translation Add-ons

- Slide Translate add-on link
- Slides to Spanish+ add-on link
- Free add-ons to translate all the text in a slideshow, creating a new copy of the slideshow with the translated text.
- More than 200 languages supported.

Recording Tools

Mote

- This Chrome extension lets you record your voice for 5 minutes at a time and add the recording as a comment to Google files.
- This can be a great way to practice fluency, or answer questions in a specific language.

Beep

- This free extension allows teachers and students to record and leave voice notes and feedback in Google Classroom, Gmail, Google Docs, Slides, Forms, and Sheets.
- Voice recordings can be up to 3 minutes each, and there is no limit to the number of recordings.
- Other people do not have to have the Beep extension to be able to listen to the recordings.

ScreenPal

- Install extension Chrome web store link
- Resources Blog post link Demonstration video
- Free and easy video recording extension (used to be Screencast-O-Matic)
 - o Record your screen, webcam, or both.
 - Record from any text box or comment field, or record from any web page.
 - Annotate on the screen.
 - Add fun special screen effects.
 - Edit the video if needed to crop to just a portion of the window, or to trim the ends.
 - Paste the link to your recording anywhere for others to view.
 - Free version allows for videos up to 5 minutes in length each using the extension, or 15 minutes in length using the desktop version.

Google Pronounce

- Search for "how to pronounce" and the word you want.
- You can now hear and see the word pronounced.
- You can adjust the playback speed.
- You can record yourself to practice speaking the word.

Docs Voice Typing

- This tool lets you speak to Google Docs and have your words typed for you. Works in many languages.
- In Docs click "Tools" then "Voice typing"
- Click the microphone icon and then speak.
- Click the microphone icon again to stop.
- Click the drop-down language menu to pick a different language.
- Also useful to practice spoken fluency.

Read&Write for Google Chrome

- This Chrome extension provides a number of tools including text to speech.
