Eight years ago, the state of Colorado launched a hemp pilot program. It came after the Agricultural Act of 2014 was passed into law. Today, the hemp industry has become a thriving sector in Colorado.

The legalization of hemp sparked a nationwide boom in CBD interest and investments. And Colorado has a better advantage compared to other states. Amid its benefits, specific regulations are being put on the substance.

CBD has become popular due to its non-psychoactive nature and side benefits. To ensure its proper use, certain laws have been made. The state of Colorado follows the general guidelines covered in the Farm Bill.

Here are a few things you need to know about CBD usage in Colorado:

Hemp Farming Is 100% Legal In Colorado

According to the [Food and Drug Administration](#), all CBD products must be derived from hemp plants. It's to ensure that all CBD products remain federally legal. CBD hemp-based products do not contain any amount of THC above 0.3%.

The THC in CBD is so low that anyone can drink a bottle of CBD oil and not get high. [Research](#) has shown that supplementing with CBD oil is one of the best ways to treat patients naturally rather than using medications with side effects.

Currently, the FDA is trying to figure out a better approval process for CBD. And until then, CBD may not claim the status of a dietary supplement.

Colorado CBD Legislation



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Colorado is still the highest state you will ever find, and we're not talking about its tall mountains. Colorado has laid out thorough regulations on CBD for the past few years. Below is a quick rundown on Colorado's CBD legislation:

- Voters agreed to the Medical Use of Marijuana Initiative in 2000. This initiative also included regulations on how patients and caregivers can use Marijuana for medical purposes.

- Colorado became one of the first two states to legalize cannabis after passing Amendment 64 in 2012. This amendment ensured that sales tax was added to the marijuana industry.

Everything was set in motion with the passing of proposition A.A. in 2013. This decision was very lucrative as CO has gained more than \$1 billion in taxes.

- The 2018 Farm Bill federally legalized CBD derived from hemp with 0.-0.3% THC content. Colorado's definition of industrial hemp was initially different from that of the federal government.

This is the primary reason why it passed Amendment X in 2018. The aim was to remove Colorado's definition of industrial hemp from the state constitution.

- Despite changing the state's definition of industrial hemp, local laws still allow the usage of industrial hemp products in food and beverages.
- With the passing of the HB 1317 act in 2022, the government reduced the amount of marijuana concentrate one could purchase. It went down from 40 grams to eight grams.

This act also requires that physicians consider their patients' mental health before recommending medical Marijuana.

This act also restricts patients under 21 to a certain level. Nowadays, many dispensaries use special software to ascertain how much concentrate is purchased by e person a day.

Colorado Hemp Resources

As we stated earlier, Colorado has been at the forefront of all efforts to create a thriving, robust hemp industry since 2014. Now there are various resources used by the state to ensure continuous production.

These include encouraging massive production, seed programs and diversifying supply chains.

How the State Works With Growers

At its peak, entrepreneurs who manufacture dietary supplements, oils, food or cosmetic products must prove that their industrial hemp ingredient is from an approved source. They must also be able to demonstrate that it conforms to the standards of the law.

This is done by the State Health Department's Hemp Program. They are responsible for the inspection and regulations of all manufacturing operations in Colorado.

All industrial hemp companies get their license from the Colorado Department of Agriculture. Once the plant leaves the farm, this department monitors the manufacturing, packaging, storage and distribution of hemp products.
