Phone and Personal Device Policy



“Off and Away During the School Day”

Student safety, privacy, and learning are our top priorities. To help protect instructional time and maintain a safe campus environment, students are not allowed to use personal electronic devices on campus.

This includes, but is not limited to:

- Cell phones
- Smart watches
- Smart glasses
- Kindles and e-readers
- Cameras
- Any type of recording device
- Personal computers or Chromebooks
- Personal tablets or iPads
- Any other personal electronic device

If a student brings one of these devices to school, it must remain turned off and stored inside the student’s backpack while on campus. Devices may not be taken out or used on school grounds before school, during school, after school, or during after-school enrichment, Youth Services, or other school-related programs.

If a student is seen with a device or is using a device on campus, the device will be taken and must be picked up by a parent/guardian in the school office.

If this happens again, the student may be required to turn the device into the office each morning. The device will be locked in a secure lock box and returned to the student at the end of the school day.

Failure to follow the personal device policy may result in tiered disciplinary action in accordance with school expectations and district guidelines.

Families are encouraged to remind students that personal devices should stay off and in backpacks while on campus so that students can remain focused, safe, and respectful of others’ privacy.
