Kelsey earned a varsity letter all four-years and had an outstanding career as a Tremper Trojan. As a Freshman, she led her team in scoring with 21 goals, and was named Freshman of the Year, as well as All-State Honorable Mention honors. Her sophomore year she scored 16 goals, followed by a phenomenal 23 goals scored her Junior year. During this season, Kelsey was named the SEC Player of the Year. In her Senior year, she led the Trojans as a captain and scored 16 goals, with 6 assists as they went on to win yet another SEC Title. From her Sophomore year on, Kelsey was honored as a member of the All-SEC Team, as well as the All-State team. She finished her four-year varsity career with 76 career goals, and not once losing a single home game as a member of the team. As well as being a member of the team to take four straight SEC Titles.

Furthermore, she was a National Soccer Coaches Association of America Academic All-American Athlete each of her four years in high school. She also was a standout basketball player her first three years at Tremper, and was named a “Top 100 Junior to Watch” in the state of Wisconsin. She also had an outstanding impact on the school community as a member of the Freshmen Transition Team, as well as a member of Tremper’s academic Renaissance Program. Fittingly, at her Senior Awards Banquet she was named “Most Athletic Female.”

Kelsey went on to have an outstanding college career as well, at the University of Wisconsin Parkside. This included 2 game winning goals her Freshman year, bids to the NCAA Division II Tournament, and being a member of a Top 10 Nationally Ranked team. Kelsey went on to graduate with her Doctorate Degree from Washington University in St. Louis, School of Medicine’s Program in Physical Therapy in 2012.
