

Urge legislatures to demand answers about detentions at Sheridan Prison.



1. Ask that all our Oregon legislators take leadership on legislation to stop this inhumane and illegal immigration policy that criminalizes human beings and traumatizes children and parents.

2. Urge your federal representatives to vote no on both GOP leadership bills.

A. Securing America's Future Act of 2018 (H.R. 4760), introduced by Rep. Bob Goodlatte (R-VA), provides three-year renewable legal status for DACA recipients but no pathway to citizenship, significantly reduces legal immigration, and eliminates the diversity visa lottery, among other harmful provisions.

B. The Border Security and Immigration Reform Act of 2018, or Ryan bill, takes a "four-pillar" approach similar to that of a previously rejected White House proposal. Key provisions include \$25 billion for a border wall; new limits on family-based migration; eliminating the diversity visa lottery; and a convoluted, decades-long pathway to citizenship for some DACA recipients — a far cry from the certainty Dreamers need and deserve. The bipartisan

Dream Act that provides a straightforward pathway to citizenship will not get a vote even though it has the overwhelming support of the American people.

3. Urge your federal representatives to pass the Joint House/Senate Bill known as the Keep Families Together Act.
