### **Uniform Guidelines**

#### (Effective August 2016):

- School cardigan, sweater or sleeveless V-neck vest is to be worn <u>daily</u>, except if wearing a jumper. [Students will be permitted to take off vests for recess]
- White oxford shirts are required on Mass days, for all grades. Students are not to wear polo shirts.
- Green shirts will no longer be allowed, effective December 2016
- Belts are no longer required.
- Grade 5 will NOT dress out for PE

Shoes	† Dress leather shoes or athletic shoes, including canvas shoes and Van style shoes, must be black, white, grey or a combination of black and white and/or grey. # **Uniform Guidelines**

Sweatshirts, or fleece jackets, of other sources, such as colleges, sports teams, high schools, may only be worn on Free Dress days or designated days.
Students may wear a winter coat/jacket of their choosing during recess on cold days. These jackets/coats may not be worn in the classroom.
All other outerwear must be a part of the St. Stanislaus uniform and requires the school logo.
Hooded Sweatshirt is available at Yours and Mine Sports
+ Girls hair accessories must match uniform colors or be in neutral colors e.g. brown, black, gold or silver.
† Girls may wear the school tie but must wear it with a button-down shirt.
† Minimal jewelry is allowed: only one religious necklace, one bracelet, one ring etc.
† Girls may wear small, stud earrings or hoops with a diameter smaller than their finger. There may not be multiple earrings in one ear. † Boys are not allowed to wear earrings.
† Hair should be neat and trimmed. Boy's hair should be above and not touch the shirt collar and trimmed around the ears. † Extreme hairstyles, including dyed hair of any color, two-toned hair, obvious highlights, are not allowed. Extreme hairstyles will be determined by the school administration.
No cosmetics, colored lip gloss or chapstick No artificial nails Only clear nail polish or clear shellac/gel No hologram contact lenses No body piercings, except pierced ears for girls Watches with a beeping device should be disconnected during the school day. Watches that beep will be taken away and available for parents to pick up at the end of the school day. Watches with touch screens such as the Apple watch are not allowed during the school day.

Students who are out of uniform will be issued the correct attire, including shoes, socks, ties, skirts, pants, etc... out of the uniform closet, and the cost of each item will be charged to your account.
