Practice

1. Download, Unzip and file bloomsAndBulbs05.zip
2. Open the plants.html file
3. Copy and paste the banner, nav and hr from the index page to the top of this page.
4. Add a level 1 header to the top of the page "Featured Spring Plant: Roses!"
5. Import, clean up and spell check the text from plants.doc
6. Click to the left of "Who can resist". Insert the rose_bud image and set the following:
 - a. alt=Rose bud on bird bath
 - b. width: 300px
 - c. height: 207px
7. Click to the left of "For ease of growing". Insert the rose_bloom image and set the following:
 - a. alt=Rose bloom
 - b. width: 300px
8. Click to the left of "The candy cane". Insert the two_roses image and set the following:
 - a. alt=Candy Cane Floribunda
 - b. width: 300px
9. **Save and view in the browser.**
10. Attach the bloomsStyle.css file to the plants page.
11. Create a new rule in bloomsStyle: Class -> floatLeft that sets the box category float property to left
12. Create a new rule in bloomsStyle: Class ->floatRight that sets the box category float property to right
13. Add the floatLeft class to the rose_bud image.
14. Add the floatRight class to the rose_bloom image.
15. Add the floatLeft class to the two_roses image.
16. Use paragraph breaks and line breaks to arrange text and images in a pleasing view.
17. **Save and preview in the browser.**
18. Create a new rule in bloomsStyle: Class -> framedImage
 - a. Border -> Apply to all checked in all columns
 - i. Style: inset
 - ii. width: 10px
 - iii. color: #8625B2 (found by clicking on the purple flower in the banner)
 - b. Box -> Margin -> Same for all UNCHECKED
 - i. left: 10px
 - ii. right: 10px
19. Click on each image. Select Class - > Apply Mutiple Classess... -> select framedImage AND the appropriate float style.
20. **Save and preview in the browser.**
21. Insert the lady_in_red image as a background image.
22. Create a new style rule: Tag -> h1 on the bloomsStyle.css with the following properties:
 - a. Color: click on the color box and then move the eyedropper to the pink of the flowers in the banner. Apply and change until pleased.
23. Check the colors in the Assets panel.
24. **Save and preview in the browser.**
