1. Upload Praxis Exam Scores <ongoing>

In order for you to maintain your status as a corps member and teach in Las Vegas, you
were asked to register for and take your Praxis Exams. For how to register, which tests to

6. Apply for UNLV < by 5/12/23>

 The University of Nevada Las Vegas is our alternate route to license and Master Degree partner. All unlicensed Corps Members need to apply before arriving in Nevada for fingerprinting.

7. Save the Dates for Pre-Service Training < reminder>

Hello Again! Find all your action items for joining the 2023 NV Corps.

- May 31-June 3: Completion of fingerprinting and certification requirements in Las Vegas
- June 8-23: Full time virtual training (there will also be several part-time responsibilities throughout the month of May)
- June 23: All corps members need to have moved to Las Vegas
- June 26-July 14: Summer teaching practicum experience
- July 17: Charter School(s) start date (varies)
- July 26: Clark County School District start date

Highly Suggested Actions

1. Navigate the Onboarding Hub < highly suggested>

2. Apply for the 2023 "Pass the Torch" Scholarship
 by 7/31>

- Teachers Test Prep, an education company that supports prospective teachers, is offering \$10,000 through its 2023 "Pass the Torch" Teacher Scholarships program. Two \$5,000 scholarships will be awarded: one to a student preparing to become an elementary school teacher and one to a student preparing to become a secondary school teacher.
- Scholarship applicants are asked to submit a video telling the story of a teacher who had an impact on them and explaining what they learned from this teacher that they would like to pass on to their future students. This enables both aspiring educators and the broader community to reflect upon the difference that good teachers can make.
