

The Society for Clinical Geropsychology (SCG) is proud to introduce a Trainee Travel Award to support trainees who want to attend the APA 2024 convention in Seattle, WA, on August 8-10 **in person**. Eligibility requirements include membership in SCG and status as a trainee (individuals enrolled in a graduate psychology program OR a post-doctoral fellowship) in psychology with an interest in the scientific or professional aspects of clinical geropsychology and attending APA 2024 in person. Priority will be given to international trainees, first-generation graduate students, trainees presenting research, trainees who do not have other sources of funds for conferences, and trainees who are attending the convention for the first time. We also welcome applications from trainees who meet some or none of these priority criteria. Applicants will answer a brief survey and submit a 250–300-word statement detailing the following:

1. Their status as a first-generation graduate student or as an international trainee (if applicable; an international trainee is considered a student or post-doctoral fellow who does not hold permanent residency/citizenship in the US)
2. Whether they are presenting research or are attending the convention for the first time
3. If they have additional sources of funding to attend this convention
4. What they hope to gain by attending the convention

The application submission deadline is **Friday, June 21st**. Up to 10 trainees will receive the \$250 Trainee Travel Award and will be recognized at the SCG awards ceremony at the APA 2024 convention. Following the conference, we will invite the award recipients to provide a brief statement about their experience at the APA 2024 convention that might be included in a future SCG newsletter. We will ask recipients to write about what they gained from attending the conference, what this funding meant to them, and/or how this travel award furthered their interest in geropsychology.
