I have the most experience in drawing content for Baldurs Gate 2, D&D, Pathfinder, Dragon Age, Mass Effect, and various other RPGs. Horror and dark fantasy content in general is what I have the most experience in.

I require clients to have a clear reference for the character(s) they wish for me to draw, either in the form of drawn references or in the form of pinterest boards/specific reference images. It's optional but appreciated for the clients to provide the pose they wish the characters to be in either a drawn format or with a specific image.

You will be provided with a high res image of the final piece through an email you provide, as well as a watermarked image if you wish to post it somewhere on the internet. I ask that you credit me when posting the piece and do not resell it, or pass it off as your own. I retain the copyright to all work I create and post the works in my portfolio, as well as to social media. All work is for personal use only unless agreed for commercial use. I do not consent to my work being used in NFT's or any blockchains, nor do I consent to my work being used in any AI generation or AI/Machine Learning. If you do not want your piece posted publicly please state so in your initial inquiry. If you want to be mentioned in the social media post with the piece, please provide an account to which I can link to or mention.

Until JUNE 2024, art is not my current dayjob, so the queue for commissions could vary between two weeks to two months. This is a loose schedule and can vary due to my day job schedule and other deadlines, please keep this in mind. If you need your art before a certain day please let me know and I will work within my schedule for you. Please send me an email or a message if you are worried about your commission or want an update! In general I work in a first pass, sketch, lineart, colours, render, and final set of stages, and you

will be emailed or messaged at each stage. Do not hesitate to ask questions or contact me if needed. All patrons get 15% off of their commissions.
