

Hi3, genshin and Hsr are connected clearly and here is how.

Before I get into anything deeper I would like to simply mention some information and then talk about evidence, why and other cases that make sense thanks to their connection. I will try to keep everything really REALLY short and simple. (◡\_◡) please mention anything you don't agree with or ask if you have any questions. I also suggest reading till the end since I have a hard time gathering my thoughts to text cuz I quickly lose interest in them. Specific sources will be linked with some information which I deemed to be pretty unknown.

Hi3 mentions the existence of Sea of Quanta quite often with bubble universes belonging to it with them being alternative or completely different universes sometimes even aligning with one another. Some getting destroyed and some getting created repeatedly, with the cycle that Imaginary Tree and Sea of Quanta is in.

Teyvat is simply another bubble universe within it and trailblazers travel through it, traveler is a trailblazer and Tsaritsa may be trying to destroy Teyvat, if you ask why there is some stuff that leads to it.

Twins come from another world, another universe. They are traveling between other bubble universes therefore they have been traveling for too long. We all know the theories surrounding the element that the twins were wielding before it was taken away from them, but what exactly does that remind us of? The light especially, players who play honkai games may immediately think of the Imaginary element, which wouldn't be incorrect. Twins come from somewhere between the Imaginary Tree and Sea of Quanta. This would make sense that we have seen them holding the imaginary element while they were trailing between universes.

You are gonna ask where does hsr fall in this, quickly mentioning something kinda unrelated to this to help you guys connect some dots, hsr trailblazers help different places but what exactly are these places? I have thought of them to be different universes with the jumps that astral express does. But we have mentioned that these games are connected so wouldn't it simply connect it to bubble universes also? Yes, what I believe is trailblazers jump between these bubble universes, in hsr we travel between them. This is why we also see different versions of characters that we know to exist in Hi3 on Hsr, because of the bubble universes aligning probably only with few changes just like seen in the main quests of Hi3.

Hold up, now considering this information and knowing that twins, traveler from genshin and trailblazers both travel between bubble universes wouldn't that make both of them play a similar role. With this information we can safely assume that travelers are trailblazers, trailblazers are travelers just with different understanding in what they do, their goals and their naming. This would also make sense with both of their abilities being able to control multiple elements naturally, unlike others in the bubble universes. Also, we can see the glider from Monstadt on Astral Express as if it had come from Teyvat or at least has origins related to there, we can safely assume a bubble universe related to Teyvat or Teyvat itself has been visited and glider was a souvenir from there.

I have one more thing that can make us suspect the relation, its seed of Sumeru from Hi3. It's a bubble universe Su created. From [another post I have read](#), I agree with some of the stuff that has been stated in it, it has also been said that in project Valuka the imaginary tree shows a

significant similarity to Irminsul. Also this similarity can also be seen within the bubble universe the player meets with Kevin, part 1 chapter 12, the tree being really similar to Irminsul. (had to be mentioned, I stopped my game cuz of shock) All of these may also be the result of bubble universes aligning.

Teyvat is being corrupted by Abyss, it is simply leaking into Teyvat through the cracks underneath like leylines, Natlan archon quest supporting this with revealing leylines are weaker therefore abyss corruption is severe.

Where is this abyss coming from anyways, how did it come to corrupt Teyvat? We know that Teyvat has three realms: Light Realm, Human Realm and the Void Realm aka the abyss. I think that it would be alright to assume that the light is imaginary, the void is quantum and the human realm is anything including others in Honkai. You can ask why, in Honkai quantum is an element of destruction and imaginary is the element of creation coming from the Sea of Quanta and the Imaginary Tree. So does that mention the quantum element is trying to corrupt Teyvat?

We know when the quantum element starts affecting a bubble universe, it's when it falls down. When the universe is close to its end and about to get consumed by the Sea of Quanta we know that it has fallen from the Imaginary Tree. This makes Teyvat a bubble universe that's getting consumed by the Sea of Quanta therefore the abyss is slowly reaching its way towards Teyvat, corrupting and destroying while it does. As an additional speculation, this may also mean the Heavenly Principles may possess imaginary element and are maybe still trying to hold onto the imaginary tree.

How did Teyvat come to fall and the major events in Genshin don't get explained by this theory? Not everything can be explained but I have considered what may have caused this abyss to erupt, the cataclysm's cause. The twins have entered Teyvat, they are prohibited to continue on tho, but why and how the timing of twins entering and cataclysm have a connection? I suggest that twins have a huge amount of Honkai, Honkai power, in them. Entering Teyvat was probably a danger for the bubble itself, they even got neutralized by the Sustainer of Heavenly Principles (who shows significant similarity to HoV, both even share the same voice actors) This energy change that twins would create by entering the bubble universe would affect the bubble greatly, maybe the Sustainer tried to prevent it but this may have really likely caused the fall of the bubble from the tree. This can be even supported by the fact that Honkai is a form of natural selection, "pruning" weak worlds from the branches of Imaginary Tree, to ensure only strong worlds survive. As much as I support this as well, it will also be mentioned later on that another event may have also affected this.

We have mentioned the extreme power of Honkai and its existence in Genshin but how exactly does it manifest in Genshin and HSR?

Houkai has the capability to make people go deranged, it can also cause 'anomalies' (mentioned many times in Hi3 by Bronya) considering this can affect the environment as well. We can give, Honkai that has collapsed the planets that some characters are from in Hi3 such as Vita (the creator, Sa) as an example. We can remember the existence of Stellarons in HSR with this information, also the power it has on the environment, they seem pretty similar? We can assume that Stellarons are some kind of Honkai power, probably an extreme one captured in a small place, creating an even greater destruction that leads to destruction of planets. This may

also indicate that Trailblazer carries a great amount of honkai just like travellers and may even be a herrscher. I can support this with seemingly insignificant information, Stellarons look like a wishing star when falling to a universe and the wish made on it results in the extreme by the Stellaron. As Kafka places the Stellaron in Trailblazer she wishes for them to find a family which is supported by Astral Express and the current extreme situations happening to them, unknown to us. How does this connect to Genshin and honkai? We know from Hi3 that extreme emotions cause Houkai power to erupt in many cases and also that Travellers were mentioned and drawn to be shooting stars falling to Teyvat. With all this information I think it's easy to connect it all. Traveler and Trailblazer carrying Stellarons which happens to be a huge amount of Houkai and this may also cause them to erupt into Herrschers. We have also experienced Welt (a former Herrscher) calm the Stellaron aka Honkai inside the Trailblazer which also supports the theory.

At the start I mentioned the fall of Teyvat from the Imaginary Tree but it can be also possible, thanks to this conclusion, that a wish made up on the falling Stellaron aka the Travellers causing the destruction of Khaenri'ah and the worsening effects of abyss which is caused by the Sea. Just a theory of mine but knowing that one wish is granted with extreme results as seen in many worlds through Hsr, it can be a possibility that one (most likely the abyss) or both of these were a side effect of the wish.

Mentioning the effect honkai has on the environment, we left out the effects on human mentality or physical health I mentioned. Well, I will be bringing a really important point to the table that has been discussed many times, the forbidden knowledge. Basically it has been mentioned as a knowledge from outside Teyvat by the Dragon King Nibelung, something that humans from Teyvat can't comprehend, which will result in them going mad. Even we were able to experience it in game with one of the npcs getting infected with forbidden knowledge for a really short time. It seemed really similar to an effect that a herrscher has under the influence of honkai like HoV while not being able to sustain itself?

Keeping that aside, we have a better deal to talk about the forbidden knowledge, the Eleazar. The Eleazar is caused by the forbidden knowledge, like withering which we see the resemblance to honkai corruption in as well. This seems really close to Honkai radiation, which is caused by continuous exposure to Honkai. It shows symptoms that include fatigue, infection of organ systems, zombification, infection patterns (which we see as an image that presents itself as purplish bluish stripes spread from a victim's arm) and these symptoms show unsurprising similarity to Eleazar, only the infection pattern being different with scales though Eleazar seems to be more severe which may also be because Teyvat is already in a bad situation. Knowing Honkai also creates Stellaron it's important to note that in Hsr it's also named "The Cancer of All Worlds".

We also know Celestia has stopped any nation that was close to finding out the truth or was fighting against it. Dropping a celestial nail on any kind of threat close enough to the fact. These Celestial nails show an extreme destructive effect to the environment. Also Celestia's arrival is depicted to be through a black hole, probably also arriving outside of the bubble universe. This also makes me question where Celestia stands since it's suggested to be the Light Realm showing imaginary elements also being destructive with extreme destructiveness which reminds us a lot of stellarons. This makes Celestia really close to Herrschers again with a big amount of houkai and belonging to the imaginary.

The Second Who Came also came from ["beyond the firmament"](#), probably referring to outside of the bubble universe. Causing havoc on Teyvat resulting in a war that destroyed both heaven and earth. We can also assume that The Second Who Came had honkai power residing in them as well. With this destruction, Enkanomiya dropped into the watery abyss. This makes me think that Enkanomiya almost got stripped from Teyvat itself but also didn't get consumed by Sea of Quanta. Following the story of Hi3 part 2 it may suggest that Enkanomiya belongs to Sea of Data where bubble universes that were almost destroyed go to, with the help of an Anchor in that story's case. If help is needed to not fall to the Sea of Quanta, we can remember that Enkanomiya got it from Istaroth who helped them build Dainichi Mikoji (the artificial sun). Getting even prohibited from going back to Teyvat till Orobashi falls, sinking to the 'Dark Sea' probably representing Sea of Quanta then finding the truth Celestia banned in [a book](#).

Primordial Sea is where most life in Teyvat existed once before, Teyvat came from there. There are places such as Fortress of Meropide and other smaller passages around Fontaine which connect Teyvat and Primordial Sea. If you remember the first chapters of Honkai Impact, you can remember or look up the place Bronya entered the Primordial Sea, pretty similar isn't it? Basically I believe that they are the same. It's also supported with Skirk being from outside the Teyvat and her pet and her existence in the Primordial Sea aka Sea of Quanta would make a lot of sense if she was a traveler among universes. It can also suggest she is somewhat like Sa from Honkai who lived in the Sea of Quanta and became a higher being.

It would also be funny and interesting to note that people of Fontaine were Oceanids created from the Primordial water. Considering that Primordial water is the Quantum element it's important to remember the reactions of Honkai elements, Quantum reacts to Quantum destroying itself. Any connection with Primordial water was death for people in Fontaine.

Also a personal theory, Tsaritsa is trying to create houkai, or a stellaron which we know to grant wishes. She is guiding the harbingers to ["burn away the old world with her"](#). Considering the theory about the wishes from Travellers being real, Tsaritsa may be trying to have a wish of her's to be reality, most likely something against the Heavenly Principles.
