The COVID Testing Tent at Methuen Family Health Center, 147 Pelham St., has a new self-swab process where people may swab themselves under the supervision of a Medical Assistant and submit their COVID test. This is a PCR test. Self-Swab hours are Monday-Friday, 9:00 am-12:00 pm. Regular Testing hours are Monday-Friday, 3:00-6:00 pm, and Saturday, 9:00 am-12:00 pm.
