Trinity Christian School Code of Conduct Form

Guests can **ONLY** be dates.

This form must be approved **BEFORE** tickets can be purchased.

Deadline to turn in and purchase tickets is **Thursday, March, 21 2022.**

To ensure that prom is an event that everyone enjoys, please obey the following rules.

1. TCS is a tobacco/vape/drug/alcohol-free campus. It shall be a violation of policy for any student of TCS to possess, consume, display, or sell any tobacco products, tobacco-related devices, electronic cigarettes, drug products, drug-related devices, alcohol or alcohol-related products, or alcohol devices at any time on school property. TCS retains the right to define said tobacco/vape/drug/alcohol products and devices. The term school property means all facilities and property, including land, whether owned, rented, or leased by TCS, and all vehicles owned, leased, rented, contracted for, or controlled by TCS for use in transporting students, staff, or visitors. **Additional information regarding what qualifies as these substances can be found in the TCS Handbook under Blackbaud Resources tab.*
2. No improper behavior, including indecent dancing and inappropriate language including singing explicit lyrics which have been intentionally eliminated in order to foster TCS's commitment to Christian conduct.
3. Students are expected to be at their classes and chapel on Thursday. Absences due to preparation for the prom are not acceptable.
4. The Trinity student and his/her date must enter prom at the same time. This means that the person designated as your date must enter with you and not with another student/group.
5. Once a student or guest exits prom, they may not re-enter. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Students must remain in designated prom areas at all times. When attendees exit the prom, they must leave the premises. Loitering is prohibited.
6. Guests must be at least 15 years old and a high school student. Any guest who has graduated high school must be **UNDER** the age of 21. All guests must provide a photo ID upon arrival.
7. In order to enter prom, students and guests **MUST** follow our provided "Dresscode Guidelines". All dresses must be approved **BEFORE** the day of prom.
8. Please make sure that social media posts do not create a false representation of our prom attire dress code. Per the TCS handbook: "We expect good judgment in all situations. Behave in a way that will make you and others proud and reflect well on the school. Regardless of your privacy settings, assume that all of the information you have shared on your social network is public information." Please be advised that we will require the removal of social media posts

that do not accurately reflect the prom attire dress code. Each student is a representative of our school both in-person and online.
