GENERAL INFORMATION

REGISTRATION

- Registration will be through [MileSplit](#). Registration closes on **Tuesday, March 10th at 10:00 PM, no exceptions.**
- Entry Fees: \$225 per division
 - Make checks payable to: Austin ISD Athletics
- Coaches' meeting will be held at 9:30 AM on Thursday. Scratches must be done prior to the start of the meeting.
- Please do not approach the timing tent once the meet begins. Find Crystal Victorino, Meet Director, for any questions or concerns.

EVENT LIMITATIONS & RESULTS

- A participant may be allowed to compete in a total of three (3) running events (including relays) and no more than five (5) events total. A participant could compete in five (5) field events provided they are not in a running event.
- Timers: BW Sports Timing, Brian Whitehead
- Individual medals for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places will be awarded along with plaques for Division Runners Up and Champions.

TEAM INFORMATION

- Team parking is in the north side parking lot (Hwy 290 side of the stadium).
- Team camps are in the north side stands. This is on a first come, first serve basis. If you set up tents in the stands, please ensure they are weighted down properly.
- Team camps on the turf are prohibited. Athletes are not allowed on Burger Stadium field unless they are checking into their event.
- Hammocks on fences are strictly prohibited.
- Please remind student-athletes to check in promptly.
 - Check in for running events will be located near the east side endzone (scoreboard).



- o Check in for field events will be on site. Pole vault certification will be on site; shot and discus will be pooled on site.
- **STUDENT ATHLETES MUST BE RACE-READY UPON ARRIVAL TO CHECK IN TENT.**
 - o No phones, headphones, sweats/warmups, bags, extra shoes, water bottles, etc.
- Warm up area is on the Annex field.
- Only spikes no longer than 1/4" are allowed for competition.
- Uniform rules in accordance with NFHS track & field rules will be enforced.
- Please inform student-athletes not to cross over yellow barrier tape or flags. Please use designated entry/exit points and refrain from sliding under the stadium railings.
- Trainers will be stationed at the field events, under the scoreboard at the east end of the stadium, and at the finish line.

SPECTATOR INFORMATION

- [Ticket sales are online only.](#) QR codes will also be available for ticket purchases outside Burger Stadium on the day of the event.
 - o Adults \$5, Students \$3, children under the age of 2 are free.
- Spectator parking is available in the south side parking lot (Jones Rd).
- Spectator seating for running events will be available in the south side stands. Seating for field events can only be accessed once inside Burger Stadium and through marked pathways to Burger Annex.

FOOD & DRINKS

- **ABSOLUTELY NO FOOD AND DRINKS ALLOWED ON TURF; ONLY WATER.**
- Water stations for athletes will be available near the field events, the Annex warm up field, and near the finish line.
- Concessions will be available beginning at 12:00PM on the south side of the stadium, home side.
- Meals will be provided for coaches, officials, judges, and staff.
