

Fenwick students and staff can enjoy free, unlimited access to New York Times News and Audio. Stay up to date on the headlines, listen to podcasts on nearly every topic and check out [New York Times inEducation](#), where you'll find journalism curated into 12 key areas of study.

Follow these simple steps to activate your New York Times access:

1. Go to nytimes.com/passes.
2. Click “**Create Account**” using your @fenwickfriars.com email and click “**Continue.**” If you do not already have an account, you will need to create a password.
3. You will receive a **confirmation email** to verify your email address to complete the account setup. **Click the link in the email** to validate your email address.
4. You will be prompted to indicate if you are **Student or Staff**. Staff access is valid for four years from the date of registration. Student access is valid until December of your graduation year.
5. You will get a notice that “You’ve Claimed your NYTimes Pass!” Click “**Get Started**” to continue setting up and personalizing your New York Times experience.

What’s included in access?

News-Only Access provides essential reporting and analysis, including:

- [News](#): Engage with expert reporting, including breaking news, culture coverage and analysis.
- [Audio](#): Enjoy full access to podcasts and audio journalism on [NYTimes.com](#), via the Listen tab on the New York Times app and on Apple Podcasts and Spotify.
- [TimesMachine](#): Explore a browser-based digital replica of all issues of The New York Times from 1851 to 2002. Education users are able to download up to five PDFs per day, with unlimited browsing.
- [The New York Times Article Archive](#): Access partial and full-text digital versions of articles from 1851 to today, with redirects to TimesMachine where applicable.
- [Subscriber-Only Newsletters](#): An exclusive collection of newsletters, available only to subscribers.
