Murphy Avenue is Sunnyvale's historic downtown, offering shops and a lively social atmosphere.

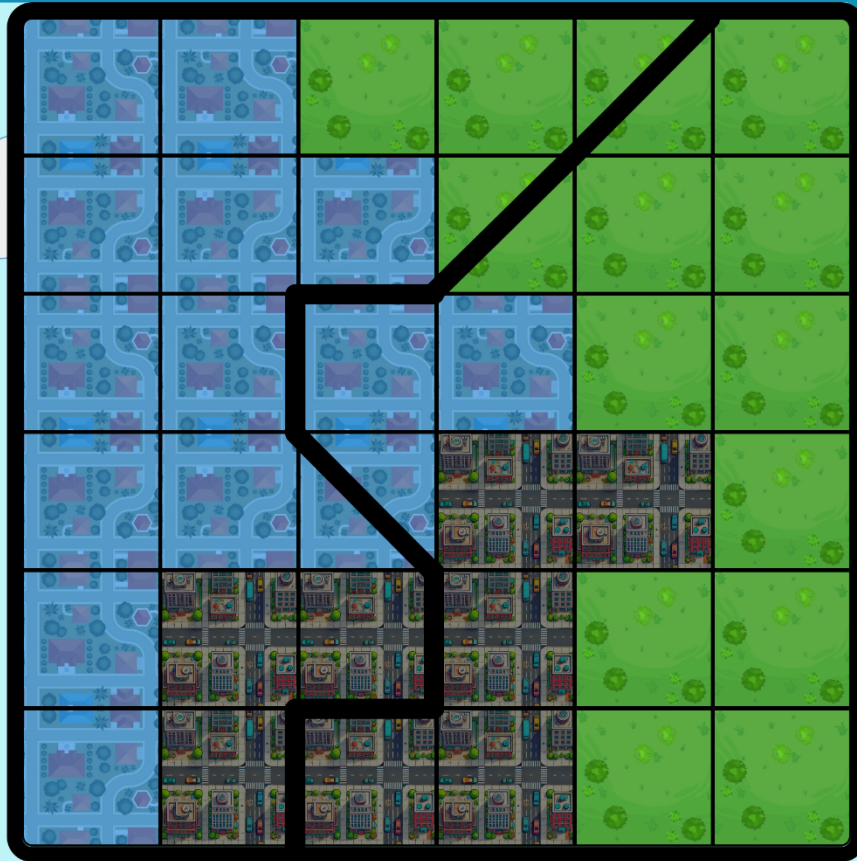


Suburbia

CityLine is a recent urban renewal development project, featuring offices and apartments.

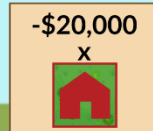
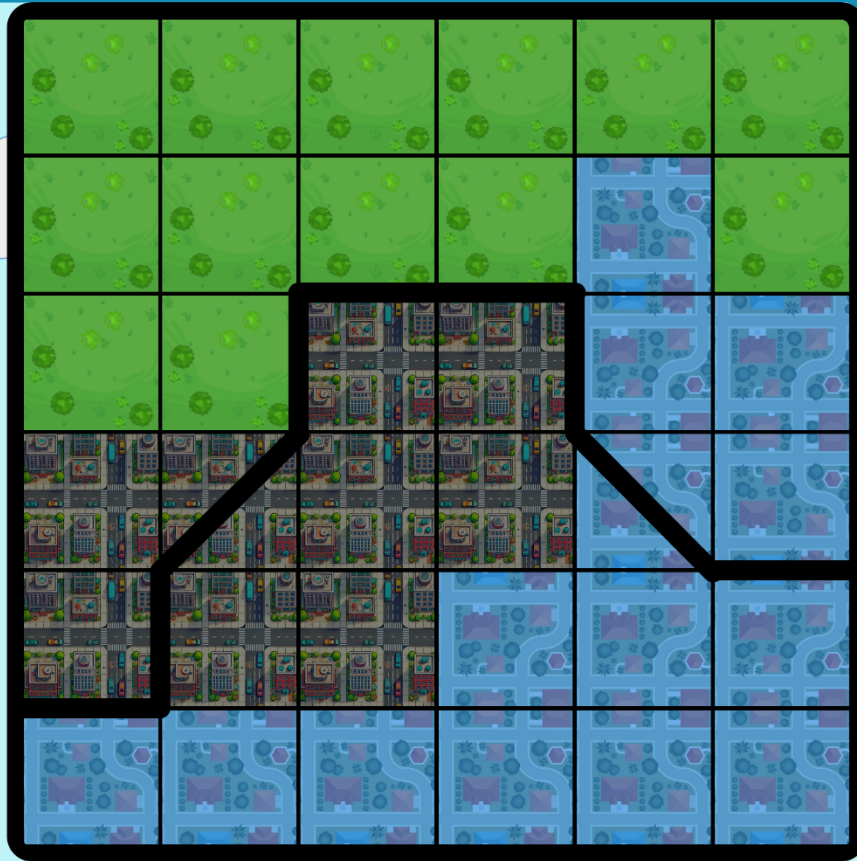


Suburbia

Springfield features a large mall with a variety of restaurants, making it a popular retail destination.

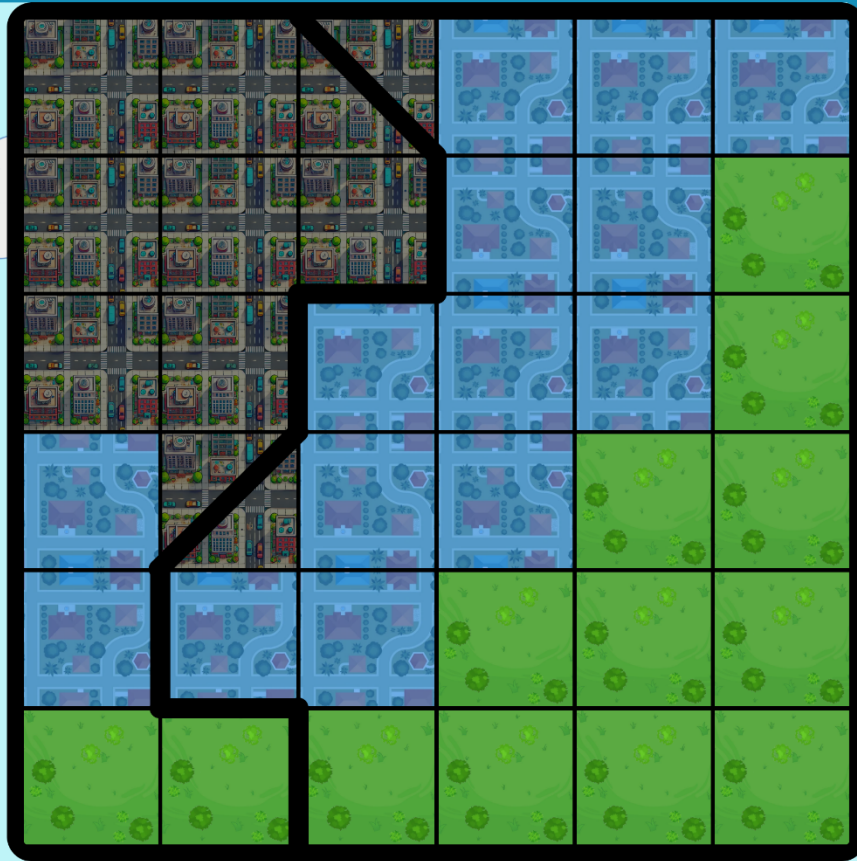

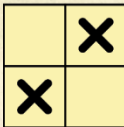

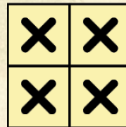

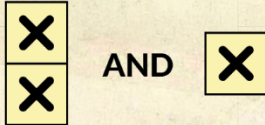

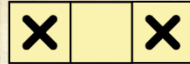

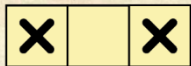

Quick Guide

On your turn:

1. Play two cards from your hand.
2. Draw two cards.

If you draw a **Housing Crisis Card**, reveal it and draw a new card. Then:

-  Add a Permitting token (add two if the Housing Crisis is in the **red zone**) to each Affordable Housing card in play. Then, attempt to construct all Affordable Housing cards with enough Permitting tokens.
-  Concern tokens block Affordable Housing. If there is no legal placement (including rotations) for the housing project on your board, discard it.
-  If you can build a project, place Housing Tokens in its shape. Whenever a project is successfully built, reduce the Housing Crisis level by one.
-  Remove the number of Concern tokens shown on the Housing Crisis tracker from the board of the player to your right.

Un-fun fact: As of 2023, there are 9,900 homeless people in Santa Clara County. 75% of them lack shelter.
