- Applicants should have access to reliable data to enable full participation in the training.
 The organisers will provide support for data costs.

- Applicants are invited to send a one page expression of interest explaining why they should be part of this training and conference.
- Applicants should provide links to three stories within the last six months.
- Applicants should send a resume (two pages or less).

- Applicants must provide contactable contact numbers in the application, including mobile numbers used on WhatsApp.
