	Shot	First flight of shot warms up when flight 3 of discus begins Flights 1, 2, 3 (in order), worst to best, Four Throws, no finals 10 minute warm up prior to each flight
	Long Jump*	Flights 1 and 2 will be run simultaneously, followed by Flight 3 Flights 1,2,3 worst to best, Four Jumps, no finals 10 minute warm up prior to each subsequent flight
	Triple Jump*	Flights 1 and 2 will be run simultaneously after flight 3 of Long Jump Followed by flight 3 of Triple Jump Flights 1, 2, 3 worst to best, Four Jumps, no finals 10 minute warm up prior to each subsequent flight
	High Jump	Flight 2 followed by flight 1 (5 cm bar moves until 1.90m then by 2 cm) Opening Height of Flight 2 (1.70m = 5'7") Opening Height of Flight 1 (1.55m = 5'1") 15 minute warm up between flights
	Pole Vault	Flight 2 followed by flight 1 (15 cm bar moves until 4.16m then by 7 cm) Opening Height of Flight 2 (3.56m = 11'8") Opening Height of Flight 1 (2.81 m = 9'2.5") 15 minute warm up between flights

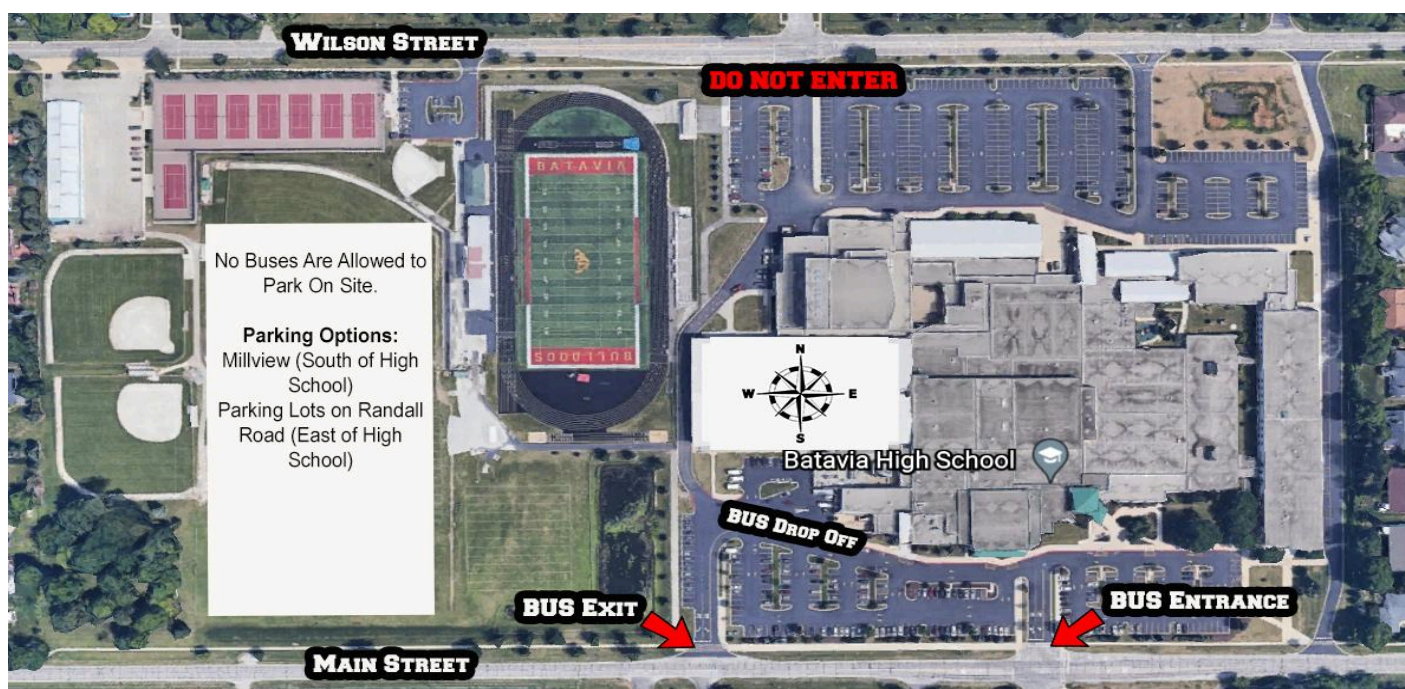
