

Campbell County Middle School Student Dress Code

Campbell County Middle School is an educational institution which should not be impacted by a student's dress or appearance. School administration may limit or prohibit any type or style of student dress, personal appearance, or use of wearing apparel that is deemed to create a disruption of the school environment or safety issue for any individual. This would include but is not limited to items with obscene, crude, or rude writing, symbols pertaining to drugs, alcohol, tobacco, weapons, gangs, violence, sexual content, racial content, or any item that suggest bodily harm.

This Campbell County Middle School Dress Code will be enforced by all staff members during regular school hours (6:55-2:45) and any time students are representing CCMS on events that include field trips, athletic events, competitions, etc., as many athletic uniforms (cheerleaders, etc.) are out of dress code. School Administration has the flexibility to adjust for special situations. Administrators will make the final decisions in regards to appropriate dress.

Tops/Shirts

- All tops/shirts must cover the shoulder. No shoulder should be exposed. All cut-offs must cover the shoulder and fit closely to the armpit area. Tank-Tops, spaghetti straps and cut-offs that do not cover the entire shoulder OR don't fit tightly to the armpit are prohibited.
- The neckline of the top/shirt should completely cover the chest area for all students.
- All tops/shirts should be free of rips and/or holes.
 - Student underwear cannot be visible at any time.

Bottoms/Pants

- All bottoms/pants are to be worn at the appropriate waist level.
- All bottoms/pants are to be free of holes to not reveal any area in which undergarments should be present.
- Dresses, shorts, skirts, skorts, and other similar fashioned bottoms must be within an acceptable length from the student's knee. Acceptable length shall be determined as follows:
 - the student garment should be at least to the mid-thigh.
- The following articles are not permitted: athletic pants with snaps, pants that are sheer and/or see through.

Shoes/Footwear

- Shoes must have backs and be worn in a safe and secure manner, staying tied, strapped, buckled, or secured at all times. No slides, flip-flops, or slippers are prohibited.

Jewelry/Hair/Skin/Make-up

- Any visible body piercings must not create a distraction to the learning environment or a safety issue for anyone in the school.
- Any alteration to hair or skin color (including the use of make-up) must not cause a distraction to the learning environment or a safety issue for anyone in the school.
- All other jewelry items will fall under the same guideline as ear piercings as it relates to distraction and/or safety.
- Visible writing (i.e., ink, marker, etc.) on the skin is not permitted.

Miscellaneous

- Tops and bottoms must overlap at all times, including when arms are raised.
- Undergarments are not to be visible at any time.
- See-through apparel is not permitted.

- The following items are not permitted to be carried around during the school day unless a circumstance requires it (example – medical need, injury). Such circumstances must be approved by school administration first.
 - o Personal electronic devices.
 - o Headphones/Earbuds are not to be worn or visible.
 - o Hats and hoods are not permitted. Head coverings, worn for religious reasons are permitted.
 - o Backpacks/Bags
 - o Purses may not be of large size. Any purse larger than 9" x 12" must be kept in the student's locker.
