

So there we were, rewatching 1969's production of Hamlet, starring Nico ("Merlin" from Excalibur) Williamson in the title role. Now, I'd reviewed this particular production for you way back in December 2002, and so we were watching it again, because Shakespeare! But that also meant that Anna Sue, her smart phone and iPad ever at the ready, had to look some stuff up on IMDb, to see what else Williamson had done. Turns out, he had done a turn in the title role in a production of Macbeth in 1983.
