Course Description

All courses will focus on the <u>NC Arts Education Standards</u> following the creative process:

-Connect -Create

-Present -Respond

Beginning Art is a semester-long course designed to teach the beginning level of Art Appreciation, Art History, Art Production, and Art Criticism. Students enrolled in this course will engage in all four aspects of art through the understanding and development of the Elements of Art and the Principles of Design. Students will understand that the production of art is an ongoing process that uses informed and critical decision making to determine outcomes to problems.
