AP Classroom Quizzes

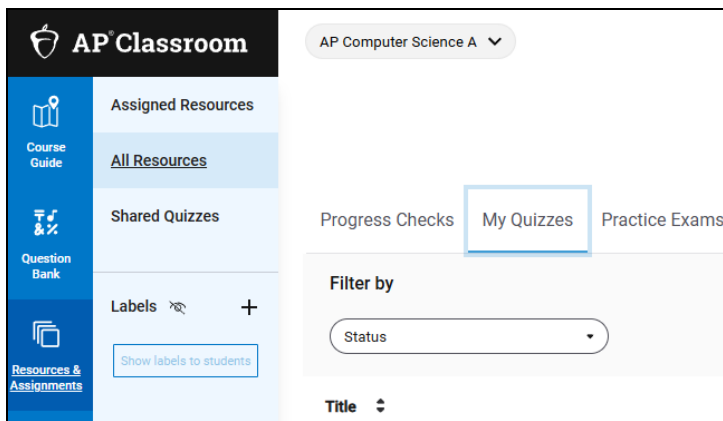
