Thank you for standing with Ukraine during these dark times. Thank you for everything you have been doing for us. There is one more way you can help. Let me ask for a favor and see what you think.

Many companies in Ukraine went out of business. Especially those focused on the local market. Many talented people lost their jobs, including developers, QA engineers, project managers, and other IT professionals.

Vast majority cannot just leave and find jobs abroad. Ukraine doesn't allow men aged 18-60 to leave the country under martial law. Women don't want to go abroad without their partners and husbands. Some cannot leave their elderly parents behind. That's why they need to be re-hired in Ukraine.

Last week alone we made 5 new hires, one engineer a day. Our current openings at Redwerk will soon be over. But we don't want to stop hiring. We want to employ as many talented people as possible so they can provide for their families.

The more engineers have jobs, the more foreign currency will flow into the country's economy. This means more taxes, more donations to the armed forces and volunteers, more purchases at local farmers, service providers, and small businesses.
