## Ornament Ideas for Advent Tree

Have fun as you prepare to make an “Advent Tree” – get a small tabletop tree to keep separate from other holiday decorations, or just add the ornament each day to your regular Christmas tree. You can either set aside ornaments you already have that fit the description suggested, buy new ones, or make them by scratch – they’re pretty easy to create at home using materials you probably already have (colored paper, tissue paper, ribbons, etc.). Make it a family tradition, be sure to set them aside for next year to revisit these devotions!

**Ornament Idea:** Animal mama and her cub

**Key Verse:** Luke 1:43

### **DAY 6: Dec. 6 – Angel Gabriel Reassures Joseph**

**Ornament Idea:** Home

**Key Verse:** Matthew 1:20-21

### **DAY 7: Dec. 7 – Joseph, Earthly Father of Jesus**

**Ornament Idea:** Walking stick

**Key Verse:** Matthew 1:24-25

### **DAY 8: Dec. 8 – Caesar Augustus, the Arrogant Ruler**

**Ornament Idea:** Counting device or ballot

**Key Verse:** Luke 2:1

## **DAY 9: Dec. 9 - Innkeeper, the Unlikely HOst**

**Ornament Idea:** A hotel (inn) or stable

**Key Verse:** Luke 2:6-7

## **DAY 10: Dec. 10 – Manger Animals, the First Witnesses**

**Ornament Idea:** Sheep, cow, goat or donkey

**Key Verse:** Luke 2:12

## **DAY 11: Dec. 11 – Angels, God’s Announcers**

**Ornament Idea:** Trumpet

**Key Verse:** Luke 2:13-14

## **DAY 12: Dec. 12 – Shepherds, Humble Evangelists**

**Ornament Idea:** Candy Cane or Shepherds staff

**Key Verse:** Luke 2:15

## **DAY 13: Dec. 13 – Christmas Prophecies Come True**

**Ornament Idea:** Calculator or microscope

**Key Verse:** Isaiah 7:14

## **DAY 14: Dec. 14 – Luke, the Doctor of Details**

**Ornament Idea:** Book or stethoscope

**Key Verse:** Luke 1:3-4

## **DAY 15: Dec. 15 – Simeon, the Elder**

**Ornament Idea:** Older man kneeling in prayer

**Key Verse:** Luke 2:26

## **DAY 16: Dec. 16 – Anna, the Faithful Widow**

**Ornament Idea:** Elderly woman holding bible

**Key Verse:** Luke 2:38

## **DAY 17: Dec. 17 – King Herod, the Monster of Christmas**

**Ornament Idea:** King's crown

**Key Verse:** Matthew 2:16

## **DAY 18: Dec. 18 – Men Wise Beyond Their Years and Culture**

**Ornament Idea:** Wisemen ornament, a treasure box (for myrrh), a gold coin or small bottle for (oil), or camel

**Key Verse:** Matthew 2:2

## **DAY 19: Dec. 19 – Angel Gabriel, God’s Protection**

**Ornament Idea:** Angel or bed or sleeping person

**Key Verse:** Matthew 2:12

## **DAY 20: Dec. 20 – Who Trained the Wise Men?**

**Ornament Idea:** Bag of seeds to indicate planting of ideas

**Key Verse:** Matthew 2:10

## **DAY 21: Dec. 21 – John, A Voice Crying in the Wilderness**

**Ornament Idea:** Twig or other “nature” ornament or leather belt

**Key Verse:** Luke 1:76, 80

## **DAY 22: Dec. 22 – Isaiah, the Messianic Prophet**

**Ornament Idea:** Dove or scroll

**Key Verse:** Isaiah 9:6

## **DAY 23: Dec. 23 – Lessons from Advent Devotionals**

**Ornament Idea:** Bible or manger scene

**Key Verse:** 2 Timothy 3:16

## **DAY 24: Dec. 24 – Jesus, Our Savior God**

**Ornament Idea:** Baby Jesus or nail

**Key Verse:** Luke 2:49

## **DAY 25: Dec. 25 – 12 Days of Christmas to Epiphany**

**Ornament Idea:** Musical note

**Key Verse:** Matthew 23:37; Luke 13:34
