

ESPAÑOL 4 COVID-19 WEEKLY CHOICE BOARD ... Try to complete one activity per column per week.

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HABLAR

Find the lyric video to a song in Spanish you like. **Sing along!**

Use <https://lyricstraining.com/es> (also available as an app) to prep and learn song vocab.

Post a video about your day to the “*qué están haciendo*” topic on the class Flipgrid. **Respond** to someone else!

Practice **reading Spanish out loud**. This helps your fluency and sense of language structure!
Read the same passage or convo 3 times out loud. Then report back to a family member in English what you read about!

Set up a time (outside of regular Zoom hours) to **chat with Señorita** (or your friends) in Spanish online!

Escribir

Write a **news report** about one aspect of the COVID-19 virus or other world news. Make it concise and formal.

Invent a short story. Make up a character who has a problem and must solve it. Include rich details. Feel free to illustrate your story and/or post it for us to see!

Write a **journal entry** about what you have done today or recently. Be sure to narrate with rich details!

Write to Señorita, talking about **what we would be doing at school** and how it would be different than your life today (*si estuviéramos en la escuela...*)

Escuchar

Download one of the **News in Slow Spanish** apps or listen on their [website](#). What did you understand?

Watch a **Spanish language movie, TV series, or documentary** on Netflix, Disney+ or Hulu. Try different versions with subtitles in Spanish (or English). What is the hardest part?

Choose one **Spanish-speaking singer** and listen to **5** of his/her **songs** today. Decide which is your favorite!

Choose an appropriate-level [Dreaming Spanish video](#) to watch. What did you hear about today?

LEER

Read a [classic children's story](#). Or [read and listen](#)! Can you summarize it in 3 sentences in English?

Translate this COVID-19 infographic. Or [this one](#). Or [this one](#). Look up another comprehensible infographic in Spanish!
