Example: • <u>Before</u> paying my bills, I always check everything.	Example: • <u>After</u> taking a bath, the detective continued searching for more hints.

✓ Notice the use of the preposition of time at in the following standard expressions:

Expression:

- at night
- at the weekend*
- at Christmas*/Easter
- at the same time
- at present

Example:

The stars shine at night.
I don't usually work at the weekend.
I stay with my family at Christmas.
We finished the test at the same time.
He's not home at present. Try later.

Prepositions of time.

Rules

- ✓ Countable nouns have a singular and a plural form. In plural, these nouns can be used with a number: they can be counted. (That's why they are called "countable nouns").

- I can speak Spanish.

Note:

In the phrase "go home" there is no article and no preposition.

- Right: I went home early.
- Wrong: I went to home.

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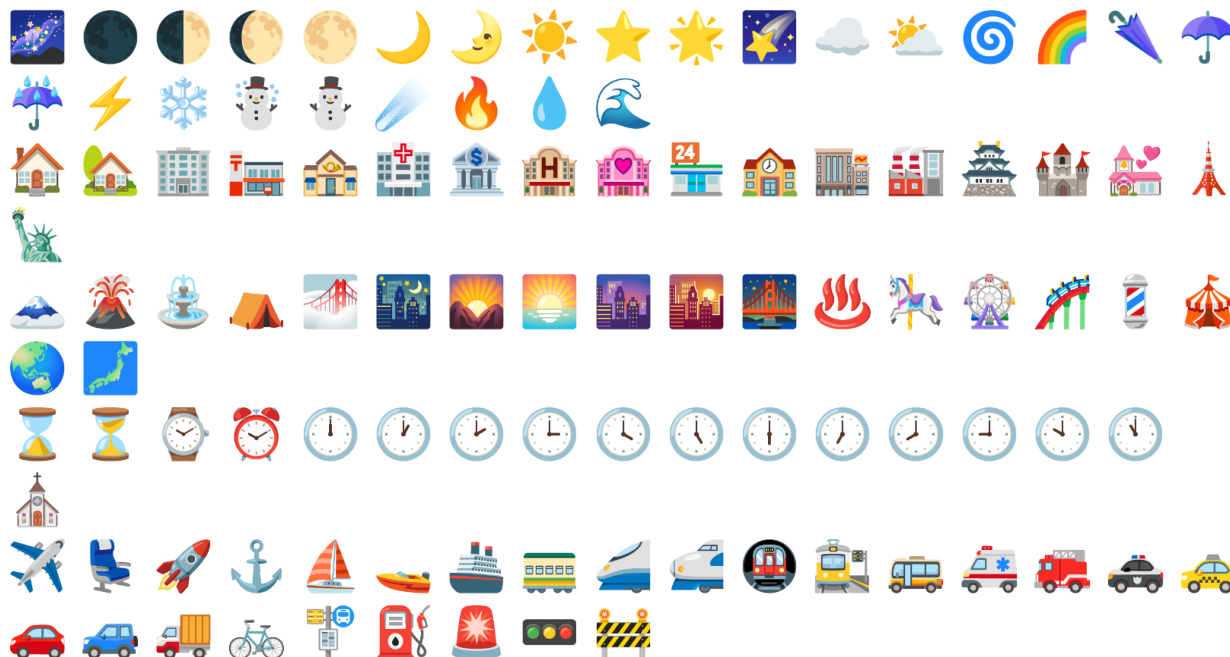
