- Unitarian Universalism or your faith journey
- Getting better acquainted or joining the congregation
- participating in a Child Dedication ceremony or your child/youth wants to talk about something with someone in addition to you
- Someone close to you is critically ill or emotionally troubled
- Receiving a home or hospital visit for you or someone else
- Personal problems...anxiety, job, children, relationship
- Getting or being pregnant; or losing or terminating a pregnancy
- Getting married or celebrating your union
- Grieving someone who died or planning a memorial service
- Being disappointed with or excited about the congregation or the minister or a staff member
- Being upset with fellow congregant and needing some coaching about how to address the person directly

Our Congregational Care and Support Teams (CCST) include:

1. The **Pastoral Care Team**, who works closely with the Senior Minister to provide ongoing support for our members and friends who are experiencing struggles of the mind, heart, and spirit including loss and grief, loneliness, aging and end of life issues.
2. The **Caring Team**, who provides practical, short term assistance such as offering meals and rides to members and friends of the congregation who are experiencing life changes, such as a birth, adoption, illness, surgery, rehab, incapacity, or a death in the family.
3. The **Memorial Reception Team**, who coordinates with family or friends when a memorial reception is held at UCE when a member dies.
