


Arrival and Departure at Maywood Hills

We receive students starting at 8:45am. Before this time there is no supervision, and students should not be on campus.

We have a dedicated bus entrance loop and main entrance loop with a parking lot connected. The bus loop is only for buses and should not be accessed by cars. Drop off and Pick up is only allowed through the front entrance for cars, **do not drop off by car at any other location or street around campus.**

ARRIVAL:



Walkers: In the morning, walkers may access any of the open back gates. After the start of the school day, the only access point will be the main entrance.

If you walk from 104th (Front of our school) and walk:

- **South** you will enter north of the church and walk through the gate onto the playground. Walk across the field and head straight to the stairs, walking to your class line up space, or walk into our cafeteria for breakfast. This gate will be locked after the school day starts.
- **North** you will access the sidewalk that runs along the south side of our campus and walk all the way to the front of the gym and past the front office gate entrance. After the school day starts the front gate will be locked and the only way to access the campus is through our main office door.

Student Drop Off by Car: Cars enter at the main entrance and drive all the way down to the roundabout by our front office. Cars should continue to move forward to the farthest available cone in the roundabout. After you arrive at a cone your student must exit on the right side of the car. After your student has exited the vehicle, continue in the line, moving when the car in front of you moves.


An adult will help monitor this line of cars. We ask that you stay in the line even after your student is dropped off and continue with the flow of traffic to get out. This might feel different at first but should quickly become routine. **This is the only location parents should drop students off by car, please do not use other entrances.** All cars should turn right out of the driveway after dropping students off. (Pick up as well)

Parking before school: If you plan on parking and walking your child in, drive in the main entrance and park in the parking lot. After parking, walk to the crosswalk that will take you north of the bus loop and enter the campus in this direction.

Buses: Students that arrive by bus will be directed to walk to breakfast or their line up spot.

During the school day: We have parallel parking spots down the car drop off loop that may be used during the day. Parents who arrive during the day should access the school through the main office entrance.

AFTER SCHOOL:



Walkers: After school, walkers may access any of the open back gates.

If you walk to 104th (Front of our school) and walk:

- **North** you will walk out the upper gate by the playground and continue north of the church.
- **South** students will walk in front of the gym and up the sidewalk to 104th.

A third location for parent walkers is at the back gates. No cars should be used at these gates. We ask that all parents picking up their students wait in one of these areas to help with congestion. The popcorn tree, library or front office are not areas to pick up. These will be very congested with our own students and their path to leave campus. Choose a location outside of our secure gates.

Student pick up by Car at End of day: Cars will enter at the front and drive down on the right side of the drive. You will join the line of cars, staying with your car at all times. As students dismiss an adult will help shuttle the cars through the pick-up area. There will be 5-6 car spots in front of the office for car pick up. Please stay in your order to help with traffic.

Daycare Vans: Should use the car pick up line.

Parking: If you park in the lot to pick up your child, please meet your child in the playground area.

Buses: After the bell rings, students will line up in the undercover area next to the bus loop and load on buses to head home.

Note for Kindergarten Families: At the kindergarten level, students must be released to another adult or sibling with parent permission. Your kindergarten teacher will discuss options with you at your Wa Kids Meeting. Please note the above choices for arrival and pick up.
