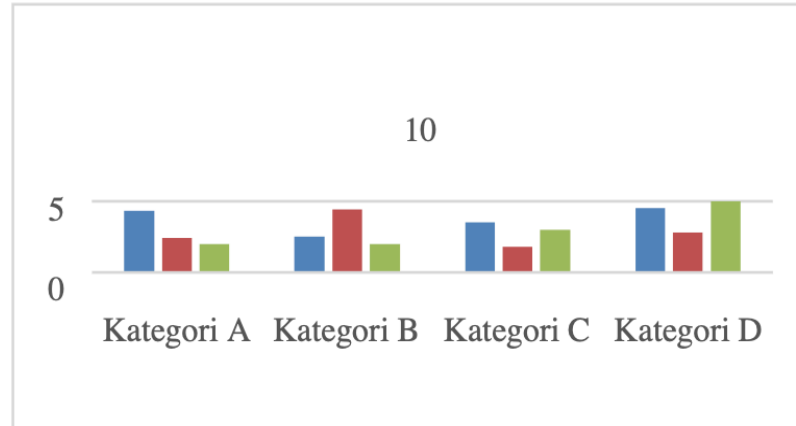


Figure 1. Example of image captions (Font Book Antiqua size 11 space 1)
