## INTRODUCTION

The Article is 5-15 pages and uploaded in MS Word format. A maximum of 12 words are used as the title of the article.

Article is divided by category; (1) research article, (2) technical article, (3) conceptual article, (4) case studies, (5) literature reviews, and (5) general reviews. The article is written in an arrangement consisting of Introduction, Method, Results and Discussion, Conclusion, Reference and Appendix (if necessary). A way to write the chapter title following this template is by selecting the available style, i.e., Heading 1.

The author must ensure that his/her writing does not contain plagiarism. Articles that have been published as proceedings are not accepted for publication in SCOPE without going through a further process to complete the paper and the final research data.

#### **METHOD**

#### 1. Heading of the Second Level

Headings on the second level are written in boldface italics using uppercase and lowercase letters. Headings are written in the align text left.

# a. Heading of the Third Level

Headings on the third level follow the style from the second level heading. Avoid using headings of more than three levels.

#### 2. Reference Writing

A way to write references can be seen in Reference section. Permitted reference types only consist of journals, proceedings, and research reports in the last 10 years.

Reference writing is done by writing references in APA style format. Reference writing at the beginning of the sentence is also the same. JELT strongly recommends using reference assistive applications such as Mendeley or EndNote. Mendeley is preferred because it does not require additional fees for application licenses.

#### RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

The stages involved in the research, the concept development or the case resolution are written in the methodology section.

Mathematical equations must be numbered sequentially and begin with (1) until the end of the paper including the appendix. This numbering must be started and ended with open and close brackets and written in the align text right. Add a blank line above and below the equation.

The nomenclature of a mathematical equation is written in a separate section after the Reference.

#### 1. Table

Information in the table is given above the table. Information is written in lowercase except for the first character in each sentence. All figures must be numbered sequentially. The table is placed in the *left aligned*. The font size used is 9 pt.

An example of making a table can be seen in Table 1 and Table 2. If the contents of the table are from a particular source, mention it at the bottom of the table with the font size 7,5 pt.
