ONLINE REGISTRATION FOR RETURNING STUDENTS

Beginning July 14th, we ask that you please log into your [PowerSchool Parent Portal](#) using a web browser. This also applies to Solomon and TLC students. The Mobile App does not support registration, so make sure you access your [PowerSchool Parent Portal](#) through a web browser. If you do not have a PowerSchool Parent Portal, please call the high school at 928-348-7050. If you have forgotten your password, you can reset it by selecting Forgot Password.

Once you log into the [PowerSchool Parent Portal](#) follow these directions:

1. Click on STUDENT REPORTS
2. Open the 26-27 SHS REGISTRATION FORM
3. Review the information in the report
4. Click on the link at the bottom of the report to verify the information or provide updated information
5. **REPEAT the process above for each student you have enrolled at SHS**

STUDENT PROOF OF RESIDENCY

PARKING LOT / LOCKER RENTALS

Parking tags will be available to purchase through the front office—in person—on Monday, July 20th at 9 AM for Senior students. Seniors may purchase a reserved parking space. All other students will be able to purchase a parking permit for general parking beginning on Tuesday, July 21st at 9 AM. General parking will not have assigned spaces. Parking spaces will cost \$60. Locker rentals will be available to purchase beginning Wednesday, July 22nd and will cost \$10. If you have questions, please contact the front office.

BUS PASSES

The 26-27 bus pass application is open. Please sign your student up as soon as possible, but please only sign your student up once. Your student must have a bus pass to ride the bus and you must reapply each year. If your student's bus is lost or damaged a replacement fee will be charged.
