Some novels cross over into multiple categories, however. These novels are placed in their dominant subcategory, but color coded asterisks are placed next to the title to indicate if other subcategories are present.

You will be assigned to a subcategory group based on your responses to the initial survey in this unit. Then as a group, you will select a novel to read together and prepare into a Literary Food Truck presentation for your class period. Additional rules for novel selection are as follows:

- Everyone must look over the books in your group's assigned category. Ways to review
 books include: general descriptions on websites like <u>Amazon</u> or <u>Books-a-Million</u>, and
 reviews on sites like <u>Goodreads</u>, as well as customer reviews on bookseller sites.
- Everyone also has the option to view books in the miscellaneous category and select an
 option from that category as well AND any books marked with your subcategory's
 asterisk in other subcategories.
- Additionally, if you want still *more* options, then you may look at <u>past winners of the Nonfiction Award</u> given annually by Young Adult Library Services Association (YALSA), a division of the American Library Association.
- No group can select the same book as another group—to avoid this happening, select a group rep to liaison with other groups on your group's choice. If there is a conflict, then one group will have to select another book.
