1. The work and its outputs

What was done, by whom, over what period, and what it produced. Methods and processes belong here.

2. The ELIXIR contribution

Which route applies, and what membership, funding, networks or infrastructure made possible that would not have happened otherwise. Be specific rather than generous.

3. Outcomes and impact, with evidence

300 words

What changed for others, and what difference that change made. Users gained, adoption figures, funding secured, citations in policy or guidance, partnerships formed, user testimony, changes to institutional practice. State the counterfactual where you can.

4. Open science, knowledge exchange and research culture

150 words

Outputs made openly available, standards adopted, materials reused by others, people trained, and how the team worked. This section is scored.
