

# Bible Lesson Curriculum: Humanity, the 1st Wonder of the Universe

Age Group: Ages 4-6

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## Goals

- Help children understand that God created them uniquely and purposefully.
  - Teach that humans are the most wonderful part of God's creation.
  - Instill confidence in God's love and purpose for each child.
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## Outline

### Welcome Time

- Greet each child warmly by name.
- Provide coloring sheets of diverse people to engage them as they arrive.

- Sing action songs such as:
    - "He's Got the Whole World in His Hands"
    - "I Am Fearfully and Wonderfully Made"
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## Lesson

### Opening Activities

1. **Mirror Activity:**
    - Provide hand mirrors for each child.
    - Ask them to look in the mirror and name something special about themselves.
    - Say, "God made each of you unique and wonderful!"
  2. **"Guess Who" Game:**
    - Display pictures of famous places and people.
    - Ask which is more wonderful—the place or the person—and explain why people are the most special part of creation.
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## Memory Verse

**Psalm 8:4:** "Then I ask, 'Why do you care about us humans? Why are you concerned for us weaklings?'"


- Practice saying the verse with hand motions:
  - "Why do you care" (point to the sky),
  - "about us humans?" (point to yourself and others).

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## Bible Story

### Genesis 1:26-28

- Tell the story using a visual aid:
  - Display a big poster or use flannel board characters showing God creating Adam and Eve.



- Emphasize:
    - God created humans in His image.
    - He gave us unique abilities and a special purpose.
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### Discussion Questions

- Who made us?
  - What does it mean to be made in God's image?
  - What special things can you do that show you are unique?
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### Gospel Point

- Humans were made in God's image, but sin separated us from Him.
  - God sent Jesus to bring us back to Him, showing how much He values us.
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### Activity (Visual Aides)

1. **Body Systems Exploration:**
    - Show simple diagrams of the human body (e.g., heart, lungs, brain).
    - Explain how God made us with delicate and complex systems.
  2. **Talents and Abilities Poster:**
    - Give each child a blank poster.
    - Ask them to draw something they love to do or are good at (e.g., singing, running, helping).
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### Craft

#### “God Made Me” Handprint Art

- Provide paper, washable paint, and markers.
  - Have children make a handprint and write “God made me special!” on the paper.
