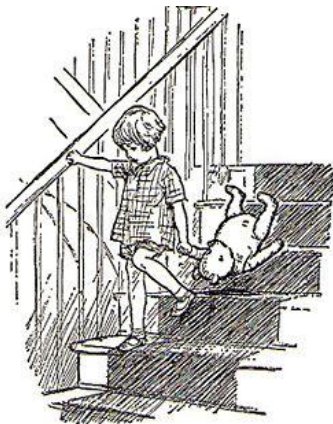
Exercise 3: Write a sentence for each image, incorporating heoi3 去 or lei4 嚟 appropriately and using directional verbs.

a. What is Piglet saying to Christopher Robin? (Use a command.)



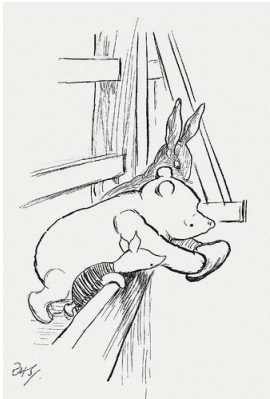

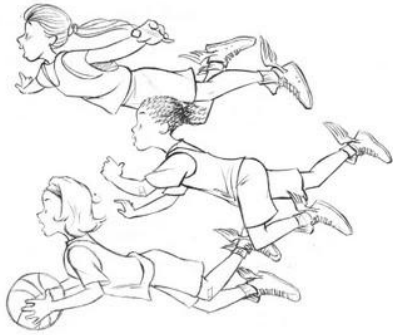
