PK/Kindergarten for next fall

If you have a child going into PreK or K next fall, the online registration is open! To be eligible for pre-kindergarten or kindergarten for the 2024-2025 school year, children must be five years of age on or before December 1, 2025. If you are unsure of your attendance area building please contact Robin at 616-669-1740 or rvandenb@hpseagles.net. We will be doing one more PreK/K screening before the end of the year for anyone that signs up late or missed the first screening date.

Hearing and vision screening is required for any child entering Pre K or kindergarten. Free hearing and vision screenings are now available at the Ottawa County Department of Public Health if your doctor office does not do this at the well child appointment.

Screenings are by appointment only. **Please call (616) 396-5266 to schedule** your child's free screening today. The department's technicians meet the State of Michigan Hearing and Vision Technician Certification criteria and will provide a comprehensive screening with each appointment.
