Your task is to create two drawings using MS Word.


- **Portrait:** This can be a self-portrait / caricature, cartoon character, etc.
- Landscape: This can be an original scene cityscape, countryside, etc.


Requirements:

- ★ The directions in this document are designed for MS Word 2010


Getting Started

- Insert a **header or footer** with your name, the date, and the title or your artistic work.
- You will have two documents for this assignment:portrait and landscape.
 - o **Tip:** you can have both orientations in one document. See how <u>here.</u>
- For the landscape document, change the page orientation:
 - o Go to the **Page Layout** tab on the Ribbon
 - Change Orientation to Landscape.
- Set the Zoom to One Page
 - \circ View \rightarrow One Page





- For each document, set the margins to narrow
 - Page Layout → Margins → Narrow
- For each document, insert a drawing canvas
 - Insert \rightarrow Shapes \rightarrow New Drawing Canvas
 - After inserting the canvas, the Ribbon will automatically change to the **Drawing Tools** tab
 - Resize the canvas to that it nearly fills the page



- For the canvas and for any shapes in the canvas, you can set fill / line colors, styles, etc.
 - Drawing Tools \rightarrow Format tab \rightarrow Shape Fill
