Willamette Valley Bag Tag Challenge 2011 Rules

- 1. Be honorable.
- 2. Tag **must be displayed** visibly on bag at all times. (Must have it on you to play/challenge)
- 3. A challenge **must be accepted** if the challenger has a tag number within 10 numbers of yours. (ex: tag numbers 20-29 must accept a challenge from tag #30) The only exception: You do not have to accept a challenge from someone who just lost their tag to you.
- 4. Challenges are for singles rounds only. (you can work out a casual doubles tag challenge, but no one is **required** to **accept** a doubles challenge)
- 5. Challenge round **must be completed** at agreed upon course/time within **two (2) weeks** or the challengee forfeits his/her tag to the challenger. (see rule #1)
- 6. If a round is incomplete, it counts as a forfeit. The exiting player must trade tags with the holder of the largest numbered tag in the group. (see rule #1)
- 7. A "tag dump" is **mandatory** at any pdga or club sponsored/associated tournament/event (All tags are put in a pile and redistributed based on score.) This can be overall or by division at the discretion of the TD or myself. (This does not include weekly rounds like handicaps.)
- 8. Any time there is a tie during a challenge, the player with the lower tag number retains the lower tag, unless a tie-breaker is agreed upon. (see rule #1) No tie breakers during tournament dumps.
- 9. Player who wins the lowest tag in a particular challenge is **responsible for updating** the tag numbers for all players in the group for the round. This is a critical part of this whole thing, because for the challenge system to work, we need to know who is holding which tag. This needs to be done on our bag tag challenge page on <u>www.discgolfscene.com</u> If you don't have access for some reason, text me your results at 828-489-1617, or by email at <u>billgaskill@gmail.com</u>.
- 10. If a tag is lost, that number will be dropped from the standings. Please report lost tags to me. If another tag is available, the loser of the tag may purchase it to get back in the league. (Yes, you will get another putter with your purchase)

Remember, some leagues have 2-3 pages of rules for these bag tag leagues. I distilled what I thought would make this run smoothly/be fun without being so restrictive/painful. This leaves us open to situations where people are going to have disputes from time to time. Rule #1 is the most important rule. Also, I'm in charge, so I may bend the rules from time to time for throwdowns, etc. (never to favor myself--I promise to obey rule #1, always). If there is an unresolvable issue, notify me, and I will put on my daddy pants. (Don't worry, they're not made out of leather OR rubber) Rule 9 is also very important. At least text me/email me results, and I'll enter them for you if you can't/are too lazy. Thanks guys.
